The Audited Draft Balance Sheet was presented in the meeting and it was approved. President said that since he was very busy with the Parliament and Assembly Elections the fixing of the date and time of the Annual General meeting could be done duly after the election is over.

Prof.Sunny Thomas informed that as per the decision of 5 District - Rifle Association/Clubs, a case was filed at Ernakulam High Court to instruct the I.G.P. to give reply to our deputation and the Court had ordered the I.G.P. to give reply within 2 months.

A letter from the so called Secretary of the State Rifle Association accusing of our club as indifferent in replying to his letters were discussed. As suggested by the President, it was decided to write to him of the Civil Case pending in Court for decision.


Secretary said that many of our members suggested starting an Archery Club under the auspices of the Rifle Club. After discussion it was decided that a separate club be organised by the Rifle Association for Archery giving preference in membership to the Rifle Club members and their children. It was also decided that the Rifle Association shall meet the preliminary expenditure for its formation and the cost of the Archery equipments be advanced by the Rifle Association. So also the Rifle Club Range be given for the practice of the Archery also, until a separate range be found or until otherwise decided by our Committee.


The Secretary and the Treasurer were authorised to take action for the above decisions.

The Secretary said that he has received 12 bore cartridges from the Ammunition Factory to be given to our rifle-owning members for practice. After a discussion, the District Collector said that since the dealers are selling the cartridges @ 17.44, we can sell it to members for Rs.17/- per cartridge after making proper entries on their Licence, and the same was approved by the meeting.
