Minutes of the meeting of the Executive Committee of the Kottayam Rifle Association held at Collector's Chamber on Friday the 30th April 93 at 3 PM.

9 Members were present.

Mr Sajan Peter District Collector presided over the meeting.

Minutes of the previous meeting held on 30.10.92 were read and passed.

Papers connected with the litigation regarding the irregularities of the K.S.R.A was placed on the table. Prof Sunny Thomas explained that we have won the case, as the final decision of the I.G.P is exactly what we wanted such as making invalid all actions taken so far by Mr P N Menon as Secretary of K.S.R.A. M/S Pothan Joseph, C A George and Dayanandan also are not eligible to be the office bearers of K.S.R.A.

The committee discussed the accounts of the Magic Show. An amount of Rs 10,8800.00 was collected and out of which an amount of Rs 4804.45 was spent for Magic show expenses. As per the understanding with officers club a sum of Rs 88995.00 is to be given to officers club for repairing of the club hall to suit Archery training and purchase of Archery Equipments a balance amount of Rs 15,000.00 is to be adjusted in the advance given by Kottayam Rifle Association to Kottayam Archery Association for the purchase of Archery equipments etc.

Extension of the Club house on the right side, was discussed as this is essential for conducting competitions. It was decided to take an estimate of expenses for the extension, pit arrangements in front of butt wall and a retaining wall on the right side of the club range. Prof Sunny Thomas was authorised to meet the neighbours who live on the right side of the range and try to get their help also to construct the retaining wall.

100 nos of semi damaged 12 bore cartridges were placed on the table. After discussion it was decided to sell it immediately at a low price to members who have license.

It was also decided to arrange a picnic on 22nd May at Kumarakom back waters.

The Secretary brought to the notice the difficulties in getting a licence renewed due to the great delay in police verification. The Secretary made two suggestions in order to raise the prestige of the Rifle Club and requested the Collector to enforce them:-

- 1) As the membership of the Rifle Association is given only after strict Police verification, police verification be removed for the renewal of the gun licence to Rifle Club members on production of a membership certificate;
- 2) When a person applies for a gun licence preference should be given to the members of the Rifle Club on production of membership certificate.


The collector agreed to do favourable arrangements to the above suggestions.


12 committee members and President Sri Sajan Peter and Vice President Sri K T Michel were present.


Minutes of the meeting held on 30th April was read and passed. The draft balance sheet for the year ending 31st March 93 ~~was~~^{was} read and passed.

The meeting congratulated Prof Sunny Thomas on getting selected
and appointed as the National Coach for shooting.

The Secretary reported that collection for the proposed extension
