

Minutes of the Executive Committee meeting of the Kottayam Rifle Club, held on Friday the 22nd November, 1963, at 5-30 P.M., at the Home Guards Club, Kottayam.

In the absence of the District Collector, Shri S. Padmakumar, the District Superintendent of Police Shri P. Balagangadara Menon presided at the meeting.

The notice calling the meeting was read by the Secretary.

- 1) Mr. P. Balagangadara Menon explained that a site near the Poly Technic Institute, Nattakam, has been found suitable for use as a Rifle Range. The meeting agreed to have the Rifle Range at this site recommended by the Chairman and decided to approach Government for obtaining necessary permission for the use of the site and the unoccupied Shed nearby, belonging to the Poly Technic Institute, for the purpose of the Rifle Club.
- 2) Membership: It was decided to canvass further members for the Club.
- 3) It was decided to open a Bank Account for the Club with the Central Bank of India, Ltd., Kottayam, the Treasurer and the Secretary were both authorised to operate the Account jointly.
- 4) Shri C.T. John mentioned that the Home Guards' Club building could be used as an office of the Rifle Club also. The meeting thanked Mr. John for this accommodation and it was agreed to have the Rifle Club office also at the Home Guards' Club building.
- 5) The Chairman explained the advantages in securing affiliation for our Rifle Club with the Rifle Association, Trivandrum, and the meeting agreed to apply for the necessary affiliation, and the Secretary was authorised to do the needful in the matter, and also to carry on further correspondence with the Rifle Association, Trivandrum, for securing necessary ammunition for use of the Club.
- 6) It was agreed that a part-time hand might be engaged for keeping the records and doing other office work of the Club, and the Secretary was authorised to engage such a part-time Clerk on a remuneration not exceeding Rs.100/- per annum.
- 7) It was decided that the inauguration of the Club be held on 1st January, 1964.

The meeting terminated at 6 P.M. with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
