Annual General Body meeting of the Kottayam Rifle Assn was held on 23rd Jul 2000 at Nattakom Rifle Range at 5.30 PM.

39 members were present.

President Sri B S Mawaji IAS (Dist Collector) presided over the meeting.

After a silent prayer for the demise of our Patron Member Sri ALEXANDER VELLAPPALLY, Secretary read the minutes of the previous General Body Meeting.

Proposed by Sri George Joseph and Seconded by Sri P C Cheriyan it was unanimously passed.

Secretary said that the Annual Report and Income/Expenditure accounts and Balance sheet were send to all members in time and Treasurer Prof SJWY THOMAS is at Delhi. Mr P K Mohan suggested, <sup>as</sup> taken as read <sup>as</sup> the accounts & reports as it was circulated earlier. President asked the members whether it may be taken as read or not. All the members agreed Mr P K Mohan's suggestion of taking taking the accounts & reports as read. Then President asked if there is any question to ~~be~~ asked regarding the Accounts & Reports etc. No body had any questions to ask. Accordingly the Income & Expenditure and the Balance sheet & reports were passed unanimously.

Next item of the agenda was election of Office bearers.

Secretary said that he received nomination of 12 members in the prescribed form duly proposed and seconded as stipulated in the by-law and the same was scrutinised and found to be correct.

Proposed by Sri Abraham Ittycheria and seconded by Sri P C Cheriyan  
P/S Cheriyan & Cheriyan was re-appointed as auditor for the ensuing year on  
the same remuneration.

" Most of the members told President that this year it takes very long  
time to get their ~~own~~ licences got renewed. Many of them have not yet got ~~their~~  
their licences renewed. In the previous years there was preference for speedy  
renewal of licences of Rifle Club members".

President agreed to take up the matter and arrange for the renewal of  
licences of Rifle Club members, as well as to minimise the delay. He  
instructed the Secretary to give a certificate along with the renewal  
application of the guns of our active life members and he also asked the  
Secretary to remind him.

Mr V P George suggested to purchase one .177 PECP SIGHT Rifle for our  
Club. The cost of the same is Rs 1 lakhs.

The Secretary said that the Club have no funds now even to purchase  
.22 cartridges from Ammunition factory which is essential for regular  
practice since the .22 cartridges available at the AR Camp is very old stock,  
and more than 50% is useless.

The Secretary also mentioned that as the Club is getting 2 new .22  
BRAD rifles from National Rifle Association of India we have to sell ~~over~~ 2 nos  
of .22 Rifles. This will <sup>also</sup> help the Club to stock some cartridges from  
Ammunition Factory.

Secretary said that sale of 2 old .22 Rifles was necessary for funds  
for the Club because we have ordered for 12 Bore Cartridges and it may cost  
Rs 35,000.00 and the allotted 2 rifles may cost about Rs 50,000.00. As such  
we have no funds to purchase .22 cartridges from Amn Factory which is  
essential. Secretary said that one Peep Sight Rifle is essential for the  
Club for the National Competitions and as such we have to find some way to  
collect some funds for this purpose.

After discussion on such points the meeting authorised the Committee to  
decide and take action on such matters and suggestions in the ~~next~~ next  
committee meeting.
