

PROCEEDINGS OF THE THIRD GENERAL BODY MEETING OF

In the absence of the President, Mr. Kuttalingom Pillai, Vice-
President presided.

1. The Secretary read the minutes of the last General Body
Meeting held on 22nd May 1965, and explained the activities of the
Club and reasons for the long suspension of the firing practice
consequent to the non-availability of cartridges. Proposed by
Shri. K.C. Thomas and seconded by Shri. P.M. Raghavan, the minutes
were then passed by the meeting.

2. The audited accounts and Balance Sheet for the year
ending 31st December 1965 and the report of the Directors, which
were circulated among the members, were then taken up for con-
sideration. Proposed by the Chairman and seconded by Shri. P.M. -
Raghavan, the audited accounts and the Balance Sheet for the year
ended 31.12.1965 and also the Directors' Report thereon were duly
approved and passed by the meeting.

4. It was decided that firing practices should be continued on all Thursdays. Mr. Kuttalingom Pillai offered the services of Havildar Shri K.N. Bhaskaran Nair as Chief Instructor of the Club and this was gladly accepted by the meeting. The meeting also unanimously elected Mr. K.C. Thomas as Treasurer, Mr. C.T. John as Secretary, and Mr. Ramakrishna Iyer as Joint Secretary of the Club.

5. Some of the members expressed their desire to obtain Shot-gun-Cartridges, and 22 Rifles through the Club. The Superintendent of Police in the Chair kindly offered his assistance in the matter.

6. Proposed by Mr. M.E. John and seconded by Mr. James Vellepally, M/s. Cherian & Cherian, Chartered Accountants, Kottayam, were re-appointed as Auditors for the current year.

7. Mr. James Vellepally reported at the meeting the decisions of the Executive Committee held earlier in the day that the membership fee due for the year 1966 be waived considering the fact that the Club could not carry on with its regular activities during the period. The meeting welcomed this decision of the Committee.
