Minutes of the meeting held in the Conference Hall,
Collectorate on 22nd of September 1975 at 5 P.M. to rejuvenate
the activities of the Kottayam Rifle Club.

The meeting began at 5 P.M. with the Kottayam D.S.P. Mr.R.P.C.Nair in the Chair Altogether forty people were present. At the outset the president explained in detail the aim of the meeting and the present condition and activities of the Kottayam Rifle Club. He appealed to the assembly to take active interest in the club and thus to spot out talent. He revealed his intention of giving a systematic training to the new members of the club by the trained and qualified policemen. In pistol shooting too, training will be given.

Though the ideal time for shooting practice is morning, because of the inconvenience of so many members, after much discussion it is decided to have the practice in the evening of Fridays and Sundays alternately. On Fridays the Police van will be starting from the Reserve Camp at 4.15 P.M. and the members who want conveyance can use it. The vehicle will be stopping before Kalarickal Bazaar and will leave for the range at 4.20 P.M. from Kalarickal Bazaar. On Sundays the van will Officers' Club Kanjikkuzhi, Kalarickal Bazaar, Members can get in from the above said place.

The entrance fee for an Ordinary member will be Rs.15/-. In addition to this he has to pay an amount of Rs.5/- per mensem. Ladies also are welcome to be the members of the club. The wife or daughter of a member is exempted from the entrance fee and monthly subscription. Application forms for membership were distributed among the office-bearers of the various social organisations and clubs present in the meeting. New members are requested to submit the filled application forms before the end of September to Mr.C.T.John, Secretary of the club. His temporary office is in Room No.1 of Restwell Lodge which is near the Boat Jetty Junction. Efforts are being done to get a permanent office room for the club. As far as possible, the secretary's clerk will be meeting the members present in the meeting in person within five or six days to collect the filled up application forms.

It was decided to restart the activities of the club on 3rd October. Those who fail to submit the application forms before the end of the month of September are requested to do so on 3rd October 1975, when they come to the Shooting range at Nattakom. The members of the club will be helped to get Arms licence to hold the weapon, if they desire so. The president suggested a plan of arranging a small game expedition on a picnic in the near future. The meeting came to a close at 6.P.M.
